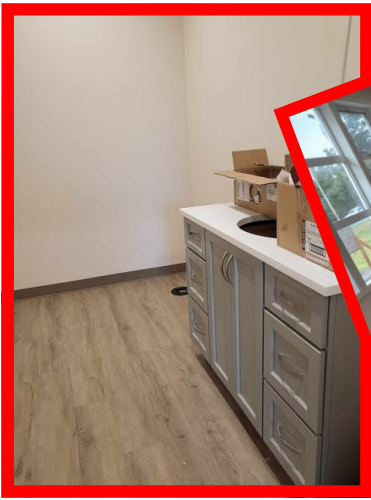

## A Forever Friend

I wonder how many people can claim they have a "forever friend"! Maybe not a sister or brother you grew up with, but someone who became a friend sometime later in life, and that you consider to be like a brother or sister. Well, I have a "forever friend". Here is a story about her.

Jane and I met at the University of Portland, the first week of our freshman year. She and I sat together in a required speech class the first week of school. We became friends that first day, and she admitted to me she was not a good student, and was worried that this "school thing" would be too hard for her, and that she was afraid of failure. Jane and I sat together after that. We talked every day about upcoming assignments, she was extremely smart, and wanted to do well. Well, she passed that speech class, and that was the beginning of a lifelong friendship. Here are some of our adventures.

Jane always had a fear of getting lost. After we went shopping together, and I tutored her about which door we had entered, her first "finding your way" lesson. And not to be afraid to ask for help... Gradually, we met new challenges...Driving in Portland was another issue, and after a few drives to different parts of town, my home, a mall, etc... she learned her way around, but always had to pay attention to what she was doing, and NOT panic. Jane encouraged ME to get my driver's license, and let me drive her car for practice. I think my dad had given up on me ever learning to drive...But Jane and I got it done!

...Psychology class...we painted our lab rats tails, and encouraged them to make abstract paintings as they scurried over art paper we had put under them....A scary hike down into a ravine, never finding the river we could hear below, and spending a night sleeping on the trail...Dad was livid we had to leave some of his camping gear down there.....A trip to a cabin on the Hoh River, and Jane thought it was the perfect time to quit smoking. She was so grouchy without her cigarettes, we had to drive all the way into Forks to save my sanity....Camping in the rain at Spirit Lake, Jane fell off a log into the lake, no dry clothes, me hollering at her for walking on that log...We built a fire to dry her clothes, kerosene added to the fire, and later, after the fire was out, we found bullets in the pockets of her jacket.....After John and I got married, she always had a "project" for him, helping collect big rocks from a quarries for a rock garden, and painting the exterior of an old flower shop she had bought...One time she called to see if we could come "help" her, I was to attend a workshop for teachers, and we couldn't come. Then she asked if John could come without me!!!! And she paid for a plane ticket for him!!!

There was always something to do when we visited Jane...Raking pine needles, building or organizing something, tearing something apart, hauling rocks, cleaning out houses, and sometimes just laughing and gabbing!!! I count myself lucky in life to have had a friend like Jane...a best friend, a sister by another mother, a confidence builder, and a partner in crime! A forever friend for sure....

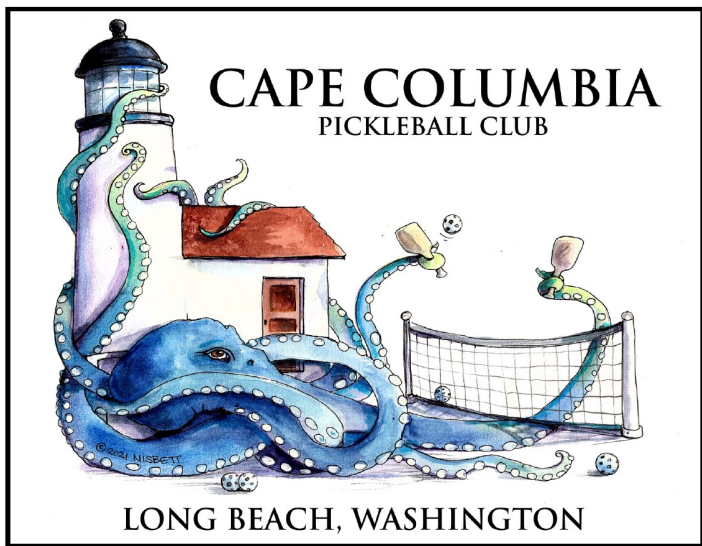

## Who Was St. Valentine?

St. Valentine is the patron saint of lovers, people with epilepsy, and beekeepers, among other things, but the real-life history of the man is unknown. There are various legends about a Christian figure named Valentine or Valentinus who was martyred on February 14 in the 3rd century AD.

In one story, St. Valentine was a Roman priest and physician who refused to convert to paganism and was executed by Emperor Claudius II in about 270 AD. Prior to his execution, he miraculously healed the daughter of his jailer. As the legend goes, he then fell in love with the daughter and, on the day of his execution, wrote her a letter signed "from your Valentine."

In another story, St. Valentine was executed because he secretly performed weddings for soldiers, who were forbidden to marry according to an edict from Claudius II.
